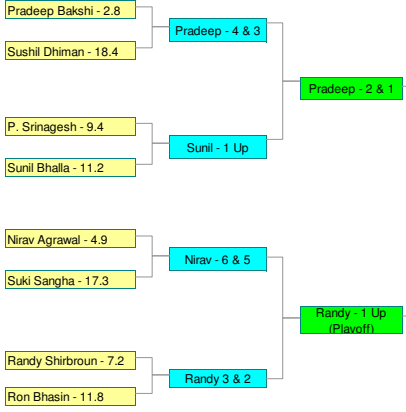
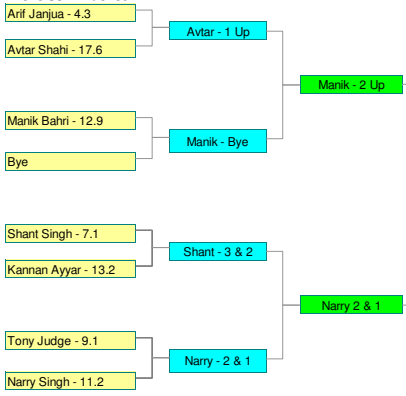

**Woods Bracket**

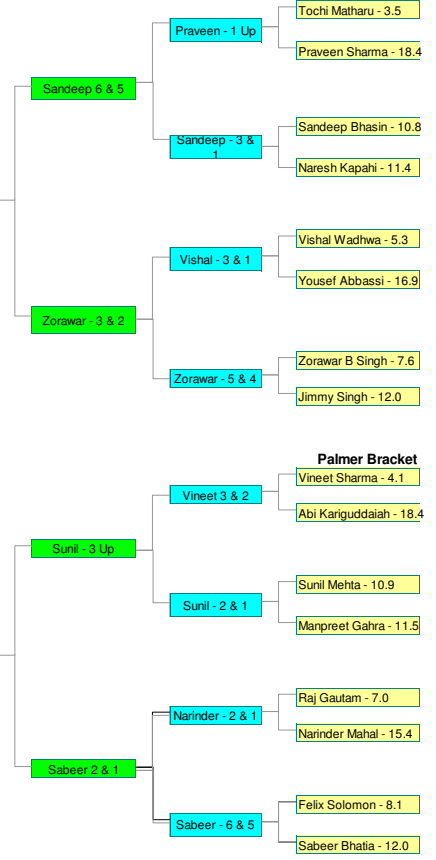


**Mickelson Bracket**

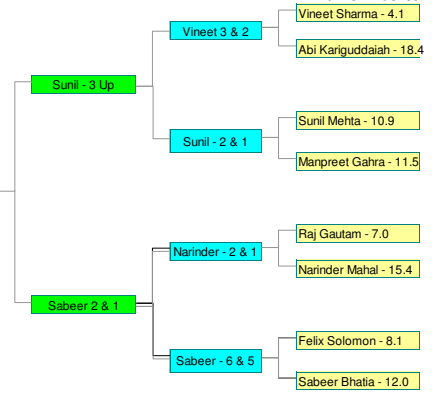

ALL ROUND 1 MATCHES MUST BE COMPLETED BY DECEMBER 31st  
ALL ROUND 2 MATCHES MUST BE COMPLETED BY JANUARY 23RD  
ALL ROUND 3 MATCHES MUST BE COMPLETED BY FEBRUARY 12TH  
ALL ROUND 4 MATCHES MUST BE COMPLETED BY END OF FEBRUARY  
FINAL MATCHES MUST BE COMPLETED PRIOR MARCH 15TH

**RULES FOR INDIVIDUAL MATCH PLAY**

- \*\* IMPORTANT NOTE.....THESE INDEXES WILL BE LOCKED IN FOR THE ENTIRE EVENT.....WILL NOT CHANGE MONTH TO MONTH
- \*\* PLAYERS IN POPPY HAVE INDEXES HIGHER THAN 12.9.....IF A MATCH INCLUDES ANY OF THESE PLAYERS, IT MUST BE PLAYED FROM WHITE TEES FOR ALL
- \*\* IF BOTH PARTICIPANTS ARE FROM PEBBLE FLIGHT.....MUST PLAY FROM BLUES
- \*\* These matches should be posted as REGULAR rounds played, NOT TOURNAMENT rounds
- \*\* All matches must be completed within the allotted time and reported to Vineet Sharma
- \*\* Results can be called in or emailed in.....please provide details of the match so we can have some fun with it
- \*\* This is a true match play.....hole by hole
- \*\* Winner of the match is player who has won more holes than holes remaining
- \*\* All 6 month low indexes must be converted to course handicap PRIOR to start of match
- \*\* A maximum index of 18.4 will be used
- \*\* The difference in strokes must be provided to the player with the higher handicap
- \*\* The strokes are given on the hardest handicap holes starting with the #1 handicap hole and so on.....
- \*\* The player with the fewest NET strokes is the winner of the hole. Player with most holes won is the winner of the match.
- \*\* In the event a Pebble Player is playing a Poppy player.....Both players will play from the WHITE tees....However, if both players are from Pebble Flight, both players must play from BLUE tees
- \*\* In the event of a tie at the end of 18 holes, players must continue play starting on hole #1
- \*\* All matches must be decided on the day of play.....cannot reschedule
- \*\* If darkness prevents extra holes from being played, must use scorecard for tie breaker
- \*\* Players must contact each other to set up the match.....email addresses are included in the attachment
- \*\* It is a request that the matches be conducted with other IAGA members present. Try to set foursomes and invite other IAGA member to play so that they can help officiate the match. If this is not possible, each match is responsible for declaring the winner AT THE COURSE.
- \*\* All issues and controversies MUST BE DECIDED PRIOR TO LEAVING THE COURSE.....use the Pro Shop to establish final rulings.
- \*\* If any doubts, play two balls and gain ruling from pro in pro shop
- \*\* For Round 1 a Bye is being given to the 2005 Club Champion (due to uneven # of players). The Bye priority is based upon - Defending Match Play Champion, Current Year Club Champion
- \*\* AND REMEMBER, THIS IS IN THE SPIRIT OF FUN AND COMPETITION.....KEEP THE INTEGRITY OF THE IAGA IN MIND AT ALL TIMES
- \*\* MATCH PLAY CHAMPION WINS \$500.....RUNNER-UP WINS \$250
- \*\* PARTICIPANTS PAY FOR THEIR OWN GREEN FEES
- \*\* COURSE MUST BE AGREED TO BY BOTH PARTICIPANTS & MUST BE IAGA CALIBER COURSE
- \*\* MINIMUM SLOPE RATING OF 136 FROM BLUE TEES (even though you may play white)
